Introducing the

SAVMA Lunch Talk Program!

Requirements

- Partner with a club to host an industry-associated lunch talk
- Secure a monetary donation to SAVMA

Who pays for the lunch?

-Clubs may apply to SAVMA for up to \$500 to recover the cost of food served at the club and industry-hosted lunch talk.

What happens to the donation?

-The money will be deposited into SAVMA's Student Activities Account, which funds educational club activities. Because all clubs are encouraged to apply for these funds, this donation will impact a wide range of veterinary students.

What does my company gain from this?

- Widespread student reach via a lunch talk
- Company logo displayed on a SAVMA donor's banner

How does my industry partner with a student club?

-Pick any! We suggest that you choose a club that will benefit most from what your business representative has to offer.

Are there any limitations?

- A maximum of 12 Health Care Vendor talks are allowed on campus per semester (24 total) so we will only accept 24 applications on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- One industry may partner with an unlimited number of clubs per year, but only one club will be allowed to apply to this program per industry donation.

Why did we introduce this program?

Previously, there has been no SAVMA funding source for the food at lunch talks. We are hoping this program will allow veterinary industries to better educate students about the resources available to them.
