Dean Lairmore on the new hospital:

\$508 million project, complete by 2030

Phase 1

- 1) Livestock center- needs to be moved out of the way, modernized and adapted now that Tulare handles most of the dairy work
- 2) Equine performance center- by the arboretum, arena to evaluate horses under saddle, also moved to allow more space
- 3) All species imaging center- consolidate small and large animal, where driveways are currently, second floor elevator to move small animal patients down, outdoor area

Phase 2 and 3

- We have half the funding for Phase 2 currently so we are not sure exactly what it will entail
- Equine surgery, etc
- 2 Isolation buildings
- New small animal building towards the parking lot- most expensive part- \$175 mil

New parking lots by VM3B and wrapping around behind VMTH

Effects on current students

- Main disruption will be trucks coming in; equine and livestock centers are essentially off site over the next 5 years
